

Artist in Residency Studio Rian de Jong, Amsterdam 2017

The Françoise van den Bosch Foundation invites jewellery artists from outside the Netherlands to apply for an annual two months working period in a studio in Amsterdam during the months May – June. Since 2000 the Foundation offers this opportunity to live and work in one of the most active jewellery communities in the world.

We offer a studio and apartment from May 1 to June 30 2017, plus a €500 grant. It is possible to extend your stay with another month at your own expense (but this should be requested beforehand with the landlord). Not included in the stay are:

- 1. Travel expenses
- 2. Materials
- 3. Living Costs
- 4. Insurance (third-party insurance is obligatory)

The studio is well equipped and includes a full-furnished apartment. Please see the website of Studio Rian de Jong for more info. http://www.riandejong.nl/stkd8/stkd8.html. /stkd8/stkd8.htm.

The studio cannot be used for heavy or dirty work (no gypsum, dust and dirt, noheavy metalworking). Further restrictions: no pets, no smoking! Limited guest stay. The apartment is appropriate for one person.

The applicant should have a professional practice as an art jeweller and be able towork at the studio on a defined project or body of work.

The applicant is a 'networker', e.g. makes contact with the local jewellerycommunity. The Foundation can assist and introduce.

The resident will install a small temporary and improvised exhibition/presentation in a street vitrine in the studio building, either at the start of the stay or at the end.

The resident is asked to give a lecture at the Rietveld Academy. The lecture is open for jewellery students and teachers of the Academy, the members of the board of the Foundation, for the friends and special invitees of the Foundation.

A brief report of the artist in residence experience (preferably on the Foundation's blog on the Françoise van den Bosch website), would be most welcome.

The Foundation is authorized to immediately terminate the stay in case of complaints from neighbours or the administrator, and if the studio apartment is not used for its intended purpose.
